The Gift Box, a floral and gift shop at French Hospital, was the source of income for CCFC and was operated by volunteer members, until its closure in 2005. This year marks our 25th anniversary.

Every holiday season, Central Coast Funds for Children partners with KJUG radio station and Golden 1 Credit Union to collect pajamas for children. *This year, the pajama drive will begin November 18 and will run through December 7.* Pajamas may be dropped off at a Golden 1 Credit Union in Arroyo Grande, Paso Robles, and San Luis Obispo.
